Companies which are using 19" components and must assemble them onto a mounting plate of a cabinet. No option for cabling from the rear side.





How to connect the assembled backplane or power supply if such a subrack is assembled to the mounting plate. The quantity of piece parts which build the subrack have to be stripped down to receive an attractive price.





Customer still needs for the control of his industrial application some 19" based PCB's and boards. Customer can still use standard accessories and the side panel includes the fixing option to the mounting plate of the wall mount case or cabinet.
